

Minuteman Program Museums

Missouri

The 351st Strategic Missile Wing Minuteman II Missile Alert Facility Oscar-01, Whiteman Air Force Base, is the only missile alert facility located on an Air Force base and is open to the public for tours. Visitors can tour the above and below ground facilities. Contact information not available.

North Dakota

The Ronald Reagan Minuteman Missile State Historic Site consists of Missile Alert Facility Oscar-0 and Launch Facility November-33 which are preserved in the Minuteman III configuration of 1997. Visitors can take guided tours of the above ground Missile Alert Facility and below ground launch control center. The launch facility tours are limited to above ground.

South Dakota

The Minuteman Missile National Historic Site outside of Rapid City, South Dakota, was established in 1999 to preserve the legacy of the Minuteman II program at the 44th Strategic Missile Wing, Ellsworth Air Force Base. The museum consists of three facilities; the Visitor Center, Launch Control Facility D-01 and Launch Facility D-09. Tours are permitted in the launch control facility where visitors can take a guided tour throughout the above ground support building as well as the launch control center. Launch Facility D-09 can only be viewed from the surface.

The F. E. Warren Air Force Base Intercontinental Ballistic Missile and Heritage Museum houses displays of reentry vehicles, parts of the Minuteman II and III missile as well as launch control consoles. Among the displays is one of two existing examples of the Minuteman I guidance system computer and stable platform.
